
NASA PONDs

A collaboration between NASA, Techshot, Inc., and the Tupperware Brands Corporation introduced a plant growth unit called PONDs..






- Philosophy, Method and Tool

 - Innovation and Problem solving, strong for ideation
- Commercialization
 - Six Sigma
 - Eliminate Variation

BRAINSTORMING



- Alex Faickney Osborn, *Applied Imagination*, 1967
 - Generate as many ideas as possible
 - Do not critic
 - Go for wild ideas
 - Combine, improve, evaluate
- Multiple variations and improvements
 - Random word
 - Cards
 - Dice

IMPROVE BRAINSTORMING WITH TRIZ

- TRIZ 40 Inventive Principles
- Genrich Altshuller analyzed a larger number of patents and identified a group of 40 techniques that inventors used successfully to solve problems
- 6 ideas (individual), 29 ideas (individual with TRIZ, 10 principles), 53 ideas (team with TRIZ, 10 principles)

Concept design; TRIZ (Teoriya Resheniya Izobreatatelskikh Zadatch)

Principle 26. Copying

A - Instead of an unavailable, expensive, fragile object, use simpler and inexpensive copies

- Imitation jewellery.
- Astroturf
- Crash test dummy
- UAV excludes pilot



B - Replace an object, or process with optical copies

- Do surveying from space photographs instead of on the ground.
- Measure an object by scaling measurements from a photograph.
- Laser anemometry
- Virtual reality
- Virtual mock-ups/electronic pre-assembly modelling

C - If visible optical copies are already used, move to infrared or ultraviolet copies


- Make images in infrared to detect heat sources, such as diseases in crops, or intruders in a security system.
- Use UV as a non-destructive crack detection method
- UV light used to attract flying insects into trap





- Prepare for the meeting with the right visual aids




COMMUNICATING WITH INTERNATIONAL TEAMS
